

Key information

- 1. Gates open at 10.30am. The event finishes at 6pm.
- 2. The event is R18. The site will be fully fenced.
- 3. Equipment arrives 30 Jan and build begins from Wednesday 1 Feb.
- 4. Pack down of the site should conclude Tuesday 14 February.
- 5. 5,000+ people are expected for the event.
- 6. Public begin to arrive from about 9.30am on event day.
- 7. Police, Fire and St Johns on the Festival site all day 11 Feb.
- 8. 40 security guards will keep the event safe and well run.
- 9. Security will be present on Uxbridge Street especially at the end of the event.
- 10. No parking on Uxbridge Street from 7pm Friday 10th Feb.
- 11. Blicks Road from Cnr Alma Street to Inkerman Street will be closed from 9am 11 Feb. Residents will receive Residents Car Passes.
- 12. Travel by bus to and from the event is encouraged via Go Bus. Bus tickets at https://marlboroughwinefestival.com/tickets-2023 or at gate for return home.
- 13. Blenheim Lions will oversee the public carpark.
- 14. Fulton Hogan staff will have signage and personnel to manage traffic on the day from 9am.
